# Blown away

Take a Kew from us and check out landscape artist Paula Hayes's terrariums. These gardens in a bottle were first created by the Victorians to cultivate delicate exotic plants, but if you want to veg out at home today, New York-based Hayes's modern reinterpretations add so much more value to a table than a mean old money tree. The sinuous glass containers are hand-blown and then Hayes painstakingly plants each piece with a pair of surgical tweezers. They're growing on us...
